

THE MAGALIESBERG is unique for its combination of trees from the warmer bushveld, the cooler highveld, as well as a dash of forest species, which find refuge in the moist ravines (signs of a wetter climate long past). This field guide makes it possible to identify the trees of this mountain range and Biosphere Reserve, from the most common to the rarest forest trees. Clear photographs show all the important identification factors. These are combined with descriptions of the features and notes on their value for cultivation.

THE GUIDE characterises the trees according to habitats in which they occur. The locations of particular tree species are also provided. By focusing on a specific geographic area, the number of species is limited, making it easy for novices to identify trees without a complex botanical key. The guide is light enough to slip into your backpack or trouser pocket. It provides valuable information to hikers, rock climbers, tourists, students, farmers and anyone interested in understanding more about the natural history of this fascinating mountain range.
